

ARIZONA K-3 DYSLEXIA TRAINING GRANT

The Arizona Department of Education's **K-3 Dyslexia Training grant** supports districts and charter schools in strengthening educator capacity and expanding the use of high-quality, evidence-based literacy practices to improve outcomes for students with dyslexia. Grant funds are designed to:

- **Ensure** each school has at least **one K-3 teacher** trained in **dyslexia-focused instruction** to support **early identification** and **effective teaching strategies**
- **Strengthen literacy instruction** for students with dyslexia and other **reading difficulties** through **evidence-based practices**
- **Align K-3 literacy programs** with Arizona Revised Statute §15-219 to provide **consistent, high-quality literacy instruction** across schools

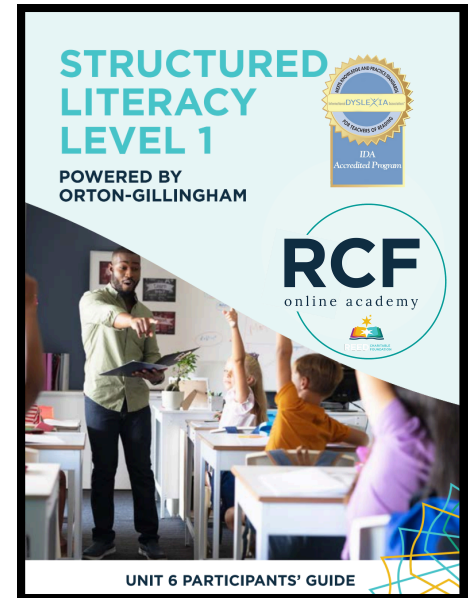
