The Oregon Department of Education’s **CLSD grant** supports districts in strengthening educator capacity and expanding the use of high-quality, evidence-based literacy practices. Grant funds are designed to:

- **Improve literacy outcomes** for all Oregon students, from birth through grade 12.
- **Advance evidence-based instruction** aligned to Oregon’s Early and Adolescent Literacy Frameworks.
- **Prioritize literacy growth** for children experiencing poverty and those in high-need schools.
- **Strengthen educator practice** through ongoing, high-quality professional learning and coaching.
- **Support alignment** between early childhood and K-12 instruction for a seamless literacy pathway.

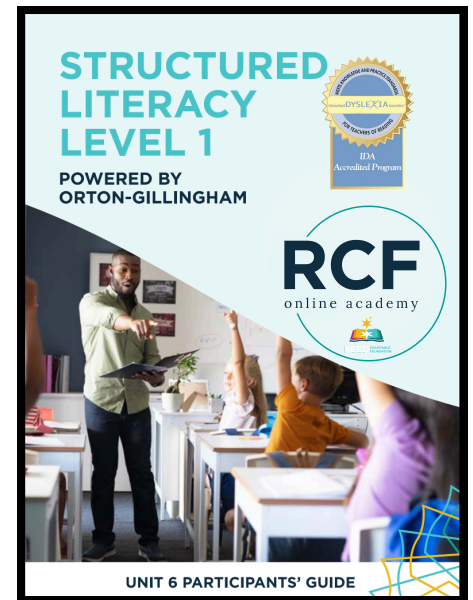


RCF’S professional development directly aligns with the State of Oregon’s literacy mission by supporting evidence-based instruction and empowering educators to make informed, data-driven decisions.
